


Tour 4 - Meah Shearim



Experience a walk through the world's most religious neighborhood & talk with Hareidi people about their culture.

Tour 5 - Old City



Visit the Churvah synagogue of Rabbi Yehuda HaChasid, Ramban Shul, birthplace of great kabbalist the Arizal, the Ohr HaChaim Shul where he studied with Elijah the Prophet, and the century-old Chabad Tzemach Tzedek shul.

Tour 6 - "770" - Chabad-Lubavitch Replica



Visit a precise replica of the synagogue in Brooklyn, New York. This edifice is famous as the headquarters of the world Chabad-lubavitch movement that housed Rabbi Menachem Mendel Schneerson's synagogue.

Experience the holiness in the city of the Kabbalists. Visit some of the old synagogues & the mystical resting places of these holy people including the Arizal, Rabbi Yosef Caro, author of Code of Jewish Law, & Rabbi Shlomo Alkabetz, author of Friday Night hymn, **Lecha Dodi**.

Arizal Mikva - Immerse in the same Mikve in which the great and holy Kabbalist immersed - the immersion is a remedy for successful business, returning to G-D and good health for oneself and one's children.

Visit the resting place of Reb Leib Baal HaYisurim to help **remove illness** and troubles. Immerse in the original Arizal mikve.

Amuka - Gravesite of Rabbi Yonoson ben Uziel, remedy for blessings for children, finding your soul mate and material success

Meron - Gravesite of Rabbi Shimon bar Yochai, author of Kabbalah magnum opus, the Zohar.

Visit old Tiberius cemetery where many holy Chasidim, Kabbalists and Rebbes are interred, including the Apter Rebbe and Reb Mendel Vitepsker.

Resting Places of the holy Kabbalist Rabbi Moshe Chaim Luzato and Rabbi Issac Halevi Horowitz, the famous Shelah HaKadosh
